

# INDIVIDUAL CAMPOUT CHECKLIST FOR PACK OVERNIGHTER

A full Cub Scout Field uniform is required for the overnighiter. Sturdy shoes that are suitable for hiking will be useful. The following is a list of equipment that would be useful on the campout. Check off each item in pencil as you lay out your equipment pack.

## Camping Equipment

- Tent or tarp, poles, and stakes
- Waterproof ground cloth or plastic sheet
- Gear for setting up tent - hammer
- Sleeping bag, pillow, air mattress or pad
- Cup, bowl, plate, knife, fork, spoon, mesh bag
- Clothesline

Clothes Bag - Pack clothes in zip lock bags to keep them dry.

- Cub Scout Field (Class A) uniform
  - Cub Scout Hat
  - Neckerchief and Slide
  - Shirt
  - Red Vest
  - Pants/Shorts (Official navy blue or green depending on rank)
  - Belt (Official navy blue or green web belt depending on rank)
  - Socks (Rank dependent)
  - Shoes
- Poncho or raincoat
- Warm jacket or coat
- Pajamas or sweatshirt, sweatpants
- Underwear
- Durable shoes, shoe laces
- Hat or cap
- Gloves (Seasonal)
- Extra socks, shoes, other extra clothing

## Family Gear

- Lawn chairs
- Cooler or ice chest
- Cot or pad
- Cooking equipment if desired. We will have 2 or more camp stoves on hand for coffee in the morning that will be available when not needed for coffee.

## Toilet Kit

- Toothpaste, toothbrush, comb
- Washcloth, towel
- Soap in container
- Toilet paper (Should be in bath house, but it is never too soon to start thinking like a Boy Scout and Be Prepared.)
- Extra plastic bag or container

## First Aid

- Personal First aid kit
- Water bottle
- Flashlight, bulb, batteries
- Sunscreen
- Insect repellent
- Whistle
- Safety pins
- If you wear contact lenses, bring an extra pair of contacts or glasses
- Any medication needed on a scheduled basis. An extra dose is not a bad idea.

## Extras

- Camera
- Binoculars
- Sunglasses
- Pocket Knife<sup>1</sup>
- Notebook and pencil
- Nature books

<sup>1</sup>Cub Scouts are only allowed to carry a pocket knife if they have earned their Whittling Chip Card. If you see a Cub Scout not properly handling their knife please take the knife away and give it to one of the Cub Scout Leaders.
